SERVICE TO THE WEST

The Western Governors' Foundation (WGF) is committed to securing the legacy of Western Governors through the performance of charitable works in the West. Reinvented as the philanthropic arm of the Western Governors' Association (WGA) in 2018, WGF currently manages two flagship projects: the *Western Governors' Leadership Institute* and *Celebrate the West*, an annual high school art competition.

In 2023, the leadership institute hosted its second annual leadership forum in Boulder, Colorado, in conjunction with WGA's Annual Meeting. Twenty-nine young leaders, selected to represent western states and tribes, participated in the forum and WGA meeting as guests of the foundation. Interest in this premier leadership opportunity is growing exponentially, as reflected in this year's forty-six percent increase in the number of applications received, forty-eight percent increase in the number of delegates selected to attend, and twenty-three percent increase in the number of states and territories represented.

Celebrate the West challenges young artists to create original works inspired by their states or otherwise evocative of the West. The recently concluded eighth annual competition was arguably the most successful in the contest's history, having attracted nearly four hundred entries (a forty-four percent increase over last year and an all-time record). Moreover, the quality of the winning artwork is remarkable and richly reflects the spirit of the West.

As we embark on a new year of service to the West, friends of the region are invited to join our efforts. Working together, there is no limit to what we can accomplish.




