Objective

The Western Governors' Association will be hosting a webinar on August 27th at 9 a.m.(MDT) to provide an overview of and solicit comments on the National Biorefinery Siting Model (NBSM). The NBSM examines the biofuels supply chain to provide an optimal network of biorefineries across the United States (site and size). This analysis includes a feedstock resource assessment, conversion technology modeling, and transportation network optimization. The model will also examine policy and economic scenarios to predict their affect on the development of the nation's biofuels mix. The webinar is being conducted to ensure that state and regional considerations are incorporated into the model and ensure that it provides a useful resource to decision- and policy-makers at the state, local and federal levels.
