

NEVADA

On May 10, 2007 Governor Gibbons issued an Executive Order creating the Nevada Renewable Energy Transmission Access Advisory Committee. The committee “will propose recommendations for improved access to the grid system by which renewable energy industries can set up and have market access in Nevada and neighboring states.” Recommendations are due to the Governor by December 31, 2007.

On April 10 2007 Governor Gibbons issued an executive order creating the Nevada Climate Change Advisory Committee. The committee will propose recommendations by May 8, 2008 on steps the state can take to reduce greenhouse gases, “including the use of renewable energy resources.”

On April 10, 2007 Governor Gibbons signed an [Executive Order](#) creating the Nevada Climate Change Advisory Committee. The Governor also appointed 13 members. The committee will make recommendations on reducing greenhouse gases, including the use of renewable energy resources, by May 31, 2008.

Energy Portfolio Standard

6% in 2005, rising to 20% by 2015

5% of the energy portfolio must be solar

2005 revisions included a significant change allowing utilities to meet the standard through renewable-energy generation (or credits) *and* energy savings from efficiency measures.
