In March [HB 412](#) was passed from the state House to the Senate. HB 412 would amend the Utah Energy Policy Act to require an economic impact study before any legislation or executive action concerning climate change can take effect.

In March the Utah Legislature sent [House Resolution 3](#) to the governor. HR 3 calls on the governor to withdraw from the WCI initiative. It passed the house 51-19.

The Legislature also enacted HB 412, amending the Utah Energy Policy Act, which requires an economic impact study before any legislation or executive action to address climate change can take effect. Senate and House supporters of the bill stated that the change in Utah's energy code was needed to guarantee that the Legislature is included in future decisions to address climate change.
