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On our August 9th conference call to begin developing a consistent set of assumptions across scenarios, I volunteered to provide information on energy and load forecasts from the Energy Information Administration's (EIA) Annual Energy Outlook for 2002 (AEO 2002). On the call I said that I thought the AEO forecasts were available at the state level. It turns out that this is not the case. Instead the information is presented at a broader regional level. For the WECC region the data is available for three sub-regions: 1) Northwest Power Pool Area; 2) Rocky Mountain Power Area, Arizona, New Mexico, and Southern Nevada and; 3) California. The attached "aio2002-load-resources.xls" spreadsheet shows AEO's peak load and energy forecasts for these three regions for the period 2000-2020. The spreadsheet also includes information on existing generation, AEO's projections for new generation additions and retirements by fuel type, as well as projections for interregional imports and exports.
