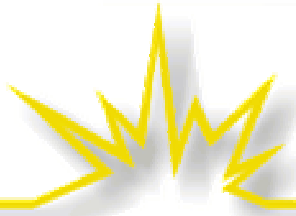

OMS Organization

- Membership—Regulatory authorities
 - Retail electricity or distribution
 - Siting
- Associate membership
 - Energy planning
 - Environmental issues
 - Consumer advocacy
- Voting—one vote/state
 - Policies referred to states for concurrence or dissent
- Funding—by MISO, \$500,000 for first half year

- Analysis

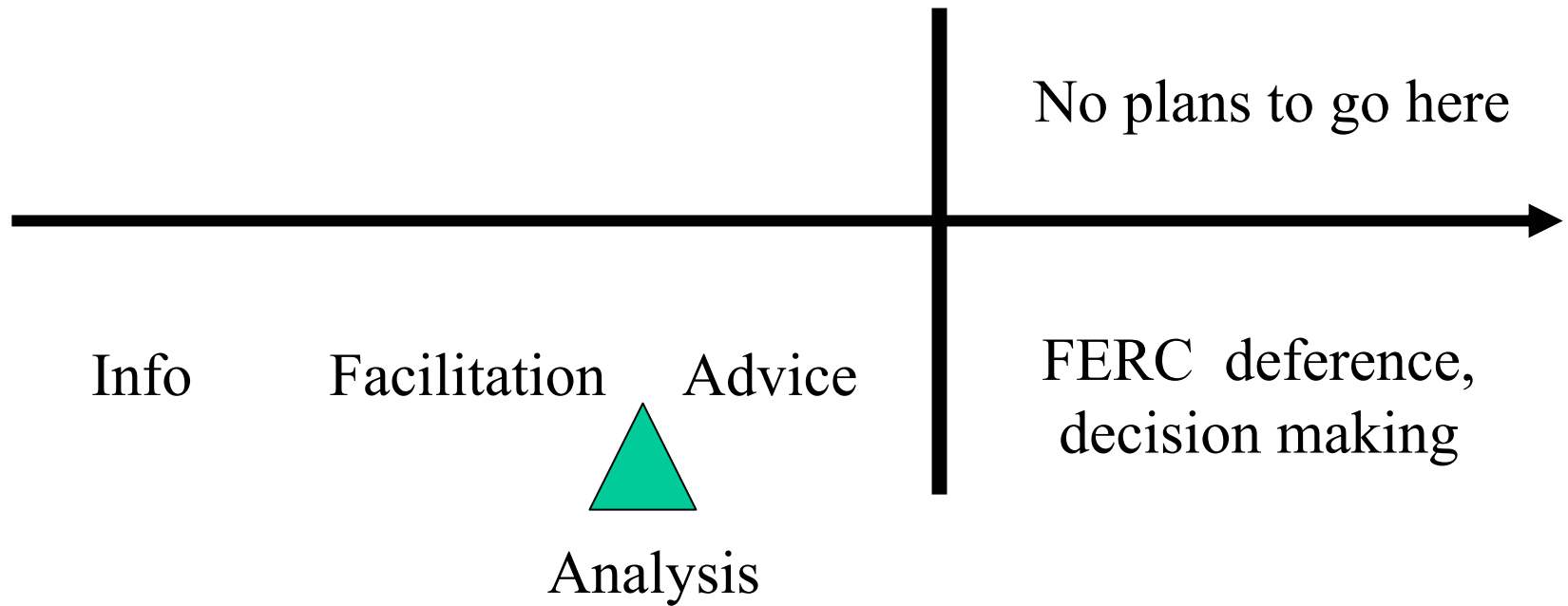
