

1. **Transparency**—CREPC and WECC approved Exhibit B—

We do not yet have the data that is public for years 4-10.

2. **Accountability**—CREPC and WECC worked in support of adequate funding for this function to be placed in the WECC budget; tracking the allocation and use of the funding is needed.

3. **Responsibility**--States and WECC have supported and been successful at increasing WECC staff support/hiring for subjects of high priority to state authorities. We have not yet however gotten clarity of roles and responsibilities for WECC staff clearly identified.

4. **Commitment**—A higher level of state staff involvement could greatly improve the quality of our thinking, our data/assumptions and questions we ask.

5. **Relevance**—The public data base, congestion analyses and transmission expansion cases are of most value when they consistent with state IRP assumptions, state renewables and efficiency policies.
